# Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

- Federal Program run by the Dept. of Housing & Urban Development (HUD)
- Given as a “block” of funding for a wide range of programs
- Programs primarily targeted to low and moderate income families (50% and 80% of the area median income)

# Community Dev. Block Grant – Disaster Recovery

- State received \$198 million
- 80% to go to 4 hardest hit areas (Edgecombe, Wayne, Robeson, and Cumberland)
- Edgecombe County's share is \$28.5 million
- Mostly for housing related activities

# CDBG-DR Housing Related Programs

Single Family Rehab	Up to \$75k in for rehab for home with damages less than 75% of pre-flood value
Single Family Reconstruction	Up to \$150k in for rehab for home with damages 75% or more of pre-flood value
Mobile Home Repair	Up to \$15k in for rehab for mobile home with damages less than 51% of pre-flood value
Mobile Home Replacement	Up to \$60k for replacement of mobile homes with damages 51% or more of pre-flood value

# CDBG-DR Housing Related Programs

Acquisition for New Construction	up to \$1 million for land purchase for new affordable housing development
Temporary Rental Assistance	Up to \$10k for households who are not able to re-enter homes for rental assistance
Home Repair Reimbursement	Up to \$25k to reimburse costs of out-of-pocket expenses to clean and repair home
Flood Insurance Assistance	Up to \$2k for 2 years for LMI homeowners in 100 yr flood plain; those receiving CDBG-DR must have FI

# CDBG-DR Housing Related Programs

Small Rental Repair	Rental unit structures with less than 10 units; up to \$30k per unit
Multifamily Rental Housing	Rental unit structures with 10 units or more; up to \$50k per unit
Supportive Housing	\$500,000 for non-construction supportive services; \$2,000,000 for construction projects; Individual \$5,000 and household \$10,000

# CDBG-DR Economic Development

Revolving Loan Fund

Up to \$750k for small businesses with documented unmet needs to recover operations; 1st round micro-businesses (<10); 2nd round all small businesses

# CDBG-DR Infrastructure

Community Recovery  
Program

Up to \$2 million for  
repair or  
replacement of  
community facilities
