

Edgecombe County Polling Places
For October 8, 2013 Rocky Mount Municipal Election and One Stop Voting

The Board of Elections defines the voting place for all precincts as the building in which voting occurs. The 50-foot buffer zone is used for all precincts. It is measured from the door of the building that is used for entry by the voters. Electioneers may place signs and distribute campaign literature any place outside of the buffer zone, but must not block the path into the building. The Board does not limit the location of electioneering outside the buffer zone, but encourages campaigners to consider their safety and the safety of voters when selecting the placement of their personnel. Also the buffer zone will apply to all one-stop voting sites in the County.
