LOW-INCOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIEAP)

The Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) gives families a one-time vendor payment to help pay their **heating** bills.

Applications will be taken for disabled persons receiving a service through the Division of Aging and Adult Services **OR** for households with a member age 60 and older, from **December 3rd** through **January 31st** or until funds are exhausted. Applications **on all other households** will be taken from February 1st through March 29th or until funds are exhausted.

Families **must** meet all of the following:

1. Household **must** meet an income test.
2. Household **must** be responsible for its heating bills.
3. Household **cannot** have resources over \$2,200.
4. The household **must** include a U.S. citizen or an eligible alien.

Bring the following information with you to apply:

1. Copy of your utility bill.
2. Information about each household member's income. If anyone works, wage stubs for the month prior to the month you apply.
3. Information about each household member's savings accounts, checking accounts, property, stocks, bonds and other assets.
4. Name, date of birth, and social security numbers of each household member.
